¹³Keep awake therefore, for you know neither the day nor the hour.

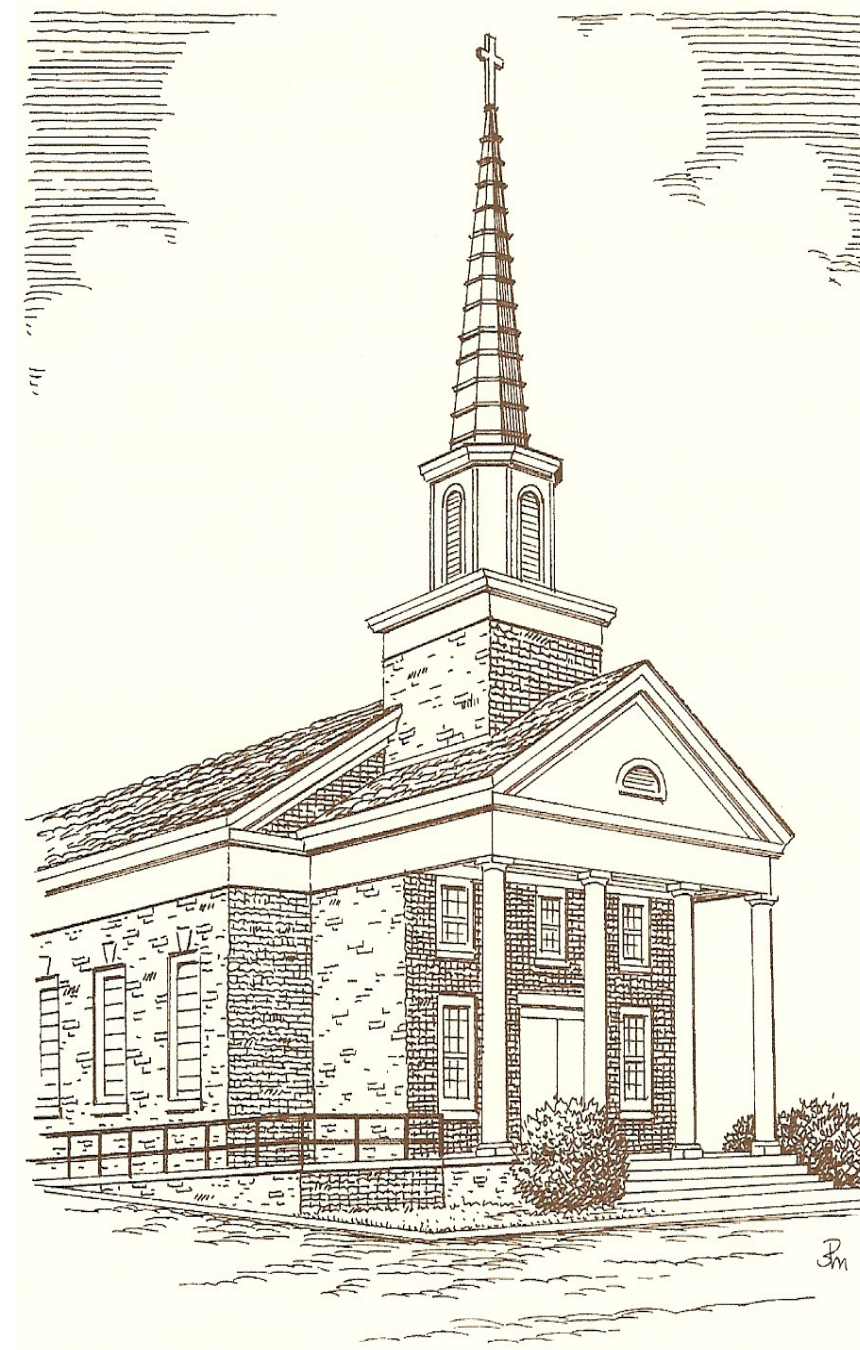
