²⁰ First of all you must understand this, that no prophecy of scripture is a matter of one's own interpretation,

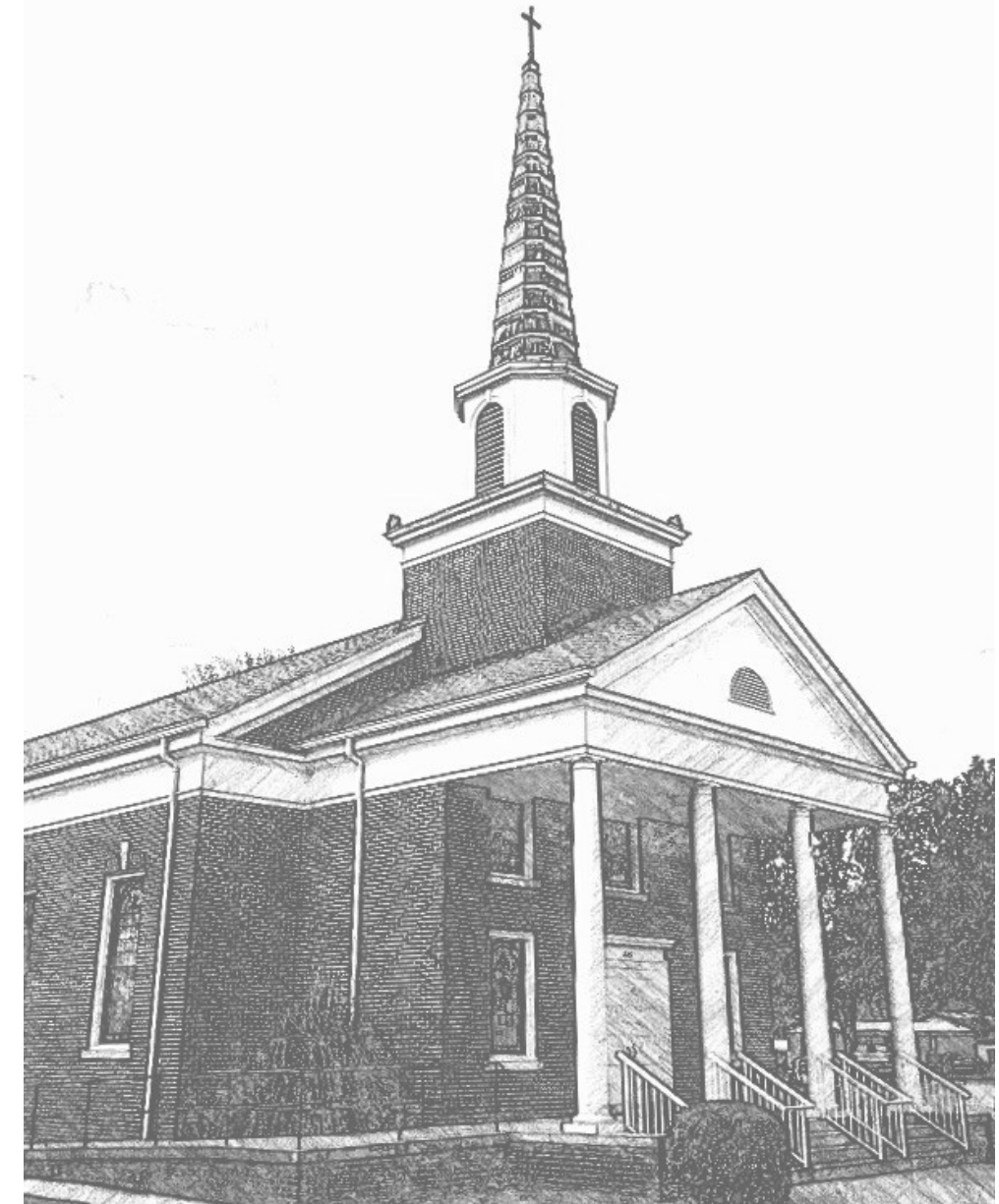
²¹ because no prophecy ever came by human will, but men and women moved by the Holy Spirit spoke from God.
