## SCRIPTURE READING

### HEBREWS 11:1-3; 8-16 (NRSV)

<sup>1</sup> Therefore, brothers and sisters, holy partners in a heavenly calling, consider that Jesus, the apostle and high priest of our confession,  
<sup>2</sup> was faithful to the one who appointed him, just as Moses also "was faithful in all God's house."  
<sup>3</sup> Yet Jesus is worthy of more glory than Moses, just as the builder of a house has more honor than the house itself.  
<sup>8</sup> do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion, as on the day of testing in the wilderness,  
<sup>9</sup> where your ancestors put me to the test, though they had seen my works  
<sup>10</sup> for forty years. Therefore I was angry with that generation, and I said, 'They always go astray in their hearts, and they have not known my ways.'  
<sup>11</sup> As in my anger I swore, 'They will not enter my rest.'  
<sup>12</sup> Take care, brothers and sisters, that none of you may have an evil, unbelieving heart that turns away from the living God.  
<sup>13</sup> But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called "today," so that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin.  
<sup>14</sup> For we have become partners of Christ, if only we hold our first confidence firm to the end.  
<sup>15</sup> As it is said, "Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion."  
<sup>16</sup> Now who were they who heard and yet were rebellious? Was it not all those who left Egypt under the leadership of Moses?
