### Tony's Tales

Well, Lent has not begun so well for us though some of us have learned a lesson about going without already. Our prayers are with those in the community who have gone without power and heat for the last few days. Since we did not have the opportunity to have a service on Ash Wednesday, we will talk about Lent on this Sunday.

During the next four Sundays, we will talk about the three traditional disciplines of Lent: Self-denial or fasting, Ostentatious Prayer, and Giving of Service. Each Sunday there will be a practical way for you to participate in this special discipline for that week of Lent.

Lent started over a thousand years ago as a time of spiritual preparation for the season of Easter. It is intended to be a time of quiet and solitude in the church. In some traditions of faith, the people do not sing any songs which contain the word Halleluiah during this entire season. We save them all for Easter, which is one reason that Handel included the Halleluiah Chorus in the Easter portion of his work, *The Messiah*.

When I was in seminary at Emory University, they built a new chapel for the University, and I discovered a wonderful place to study in the upper balcony of the chapel. It was a quiet and solitary place.

One of the last pieces of the construction was to build the pipe organ for the chapel. It was constructed in a workshop somewhere, then taken apart, piece by piece, labeled and moved to the chapel.

They laid all of the parts out on the floor of the chapel. There were over 3,000 parts. As they began to put them together, I became fascinated at the craftsmanship and patience of the workers.

Over the 40 days that it took to rebuild the organ and test it, my studying suffered, but my admiration grew. I was there when the organist came on the first day to play it. His name was Joe.

When we take the time to be intentional and to grow according to God's plan, our rejoicing and joy are made more complete.

Lent is about putting our life and its priorities within the will and plan of God. In the work that it takes to craft our life, we find freedom in form and blessings in obedience.

May you have a happy and productive Lent.




