# **Tony's Tales**

It was one of those times when I thought I knew what someone was going to say before they said it. I was listening to someone give a talk about whether the proverbial glass was half empty or half full. I am sure my face had that look on it that I have seen many times before when I have read a familiar scripture lesson. The look says, "I have already heard this lesson a thousand times. I know it backwards and forwards. I have read what many scholars have had to say about this. You are not going to surprise me."

I listened patiently as this person described the difference between how people see the glass. Those who are optimistic see the glass as half full. Those who are pessimistic see the glass as half empty. Some smart-alecky people will say it is half full of liquid and half full of air. Some opportunistic people will say, "Hey, are you going to drink the rest of that?" You get the drift.

And then, this person said something that I had not thought about before this time. It describes the church's way of looking at the glass in the best way I have ever heard. It considers that sometimes our spirit is down, and sometimes we are optimistic. When we get down, however, we often get discouraged to the point of not knowing how to proceed. The Christian answer to the problem of the glass is that it is REFILLABLE. We are not in this alone; God is with us. God's Holy Spirit has the power to refill our personal spirits when we are down, to pick us up, and give us purpose again. We do not have to look at the past and think about how things used to be. We can think about how things are now and how they are going to be.

God calls all of us to worship and love Him. He also calls us to love one another. These acts of loving will carry us through many good times and many bad times, but when our strength runs out; when our capacity to love gives out; when our witness is weak because we are discouraged, God fills us with His Spirit.

As we continue our witness as the church, and as individual Christians following Easter, let us rely on God's Holy Spirit to give us the strength, the ability to love, and the courage to witness to all that God is doing in this world. Drink deeply of His love. There is plenty more.

"But whoever drinks the water I give them will never thirst. Indeed, the water I give them will become in them a spring of water welling up to eternal life." John 4:14.




