The General Conference of the UMC will be held in Portland, OR, from May 10-20, 2016. They will work to set the direction or the ministry of our churches. It has been exciting to see how the UMC has grown into a real worldwide church in the last 20 years.

The Temple Mission Trip, We Are Holston, is May 27-June 2. We will serve at the Sprouting Hope Community Garden in Marion, VA. It is a ministry of the Holston Conference, First UMC Marion, and Hungry, another Lutheran Camp. Sprouting Hope provides fresh food to the food bank, teaches nutrition in local schools, as well as creating and managing the local farmers market. The Mission Farmer is Jason Von Kundra.

Then the group will transition to Elk Garden School Ministry. This decommissioned elementary school outside Lebanon, Virginia, is being transformed into a ministry center that will offer a thrift store, educational opportunities, and various ministry services that are appropriate. The Rev. Brooke Atchley, a missionary of the General Board of Global Ministries, serves this mission. We will assist in the completion of projects at the building and also serve in mission in the community to those who have applied for assistance in various areas of home rehabilitation.

During this month, we will also collect items for food buckets to be sent to Liberia to help the people of this struggling country. The ties that the Holston Conference has with Liberia are strong. Through many wars, through the Ebola crisis, and through many years of pain, the Holston Conference has been there to support the people of this country. We have told them about the love of God, but we have shown it to them as well. It is a blessing to have the opportunity to work with people throughout the world, who are our brothers and sisters in Christ.

Watch the bulletins during each week in May. We will talk about who we are as the United Methodist Church and the work that happens because of the work of those who have gone before us, and the work of those who walk beside us today.
