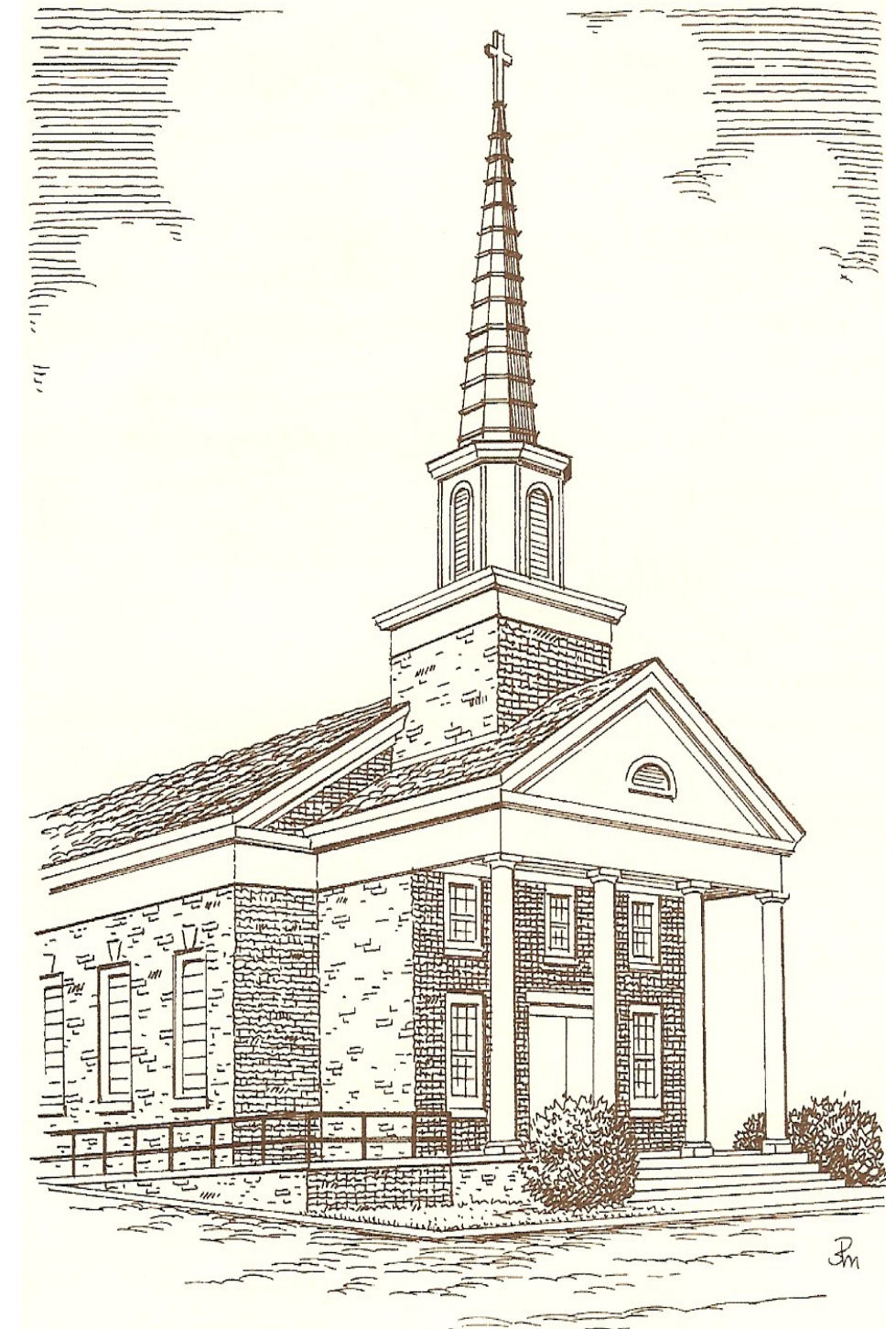
¹ As he came out of the temple, one of his disciples said to him, "Look, Teacher, what large stones and what large buildings!"
