#### SCRIPTURE READING 2 TIMOTHY 3:4-4:5 (NRSV)

- <sup>4</sup> treacherous, reckless, swollen with conceit, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God,
- <sup>5</sup> holding to the outward form of godliness but denying its power. Avoid them!
- <sup>6</sup> For among them are those who make their way into households and captivate silly women, overwhelmed by their sins and swayed by all kinds of desires,
- <sup>7</sup> who are always being instructed and can never arrive at a knowledge of the truth.
- <sup>8</sup> As Jannes and Jambres opposed Moses, so these people, of corrupt mind and counterfeit faith, also oppose the truth.
- <sup>9</sup> But they will not make much progress, because, as in the case of those two men, their folly will become plain to everyone.
- 10 Now you have observed my teaching, my conduct, my aim in life, my faith, my patience, my love, my steadfastness,
- <sup>11</sup> my persecutions, and my suffering the things that happened to me in Antioch, Iconium, and Lystra. What persecutions I endured! Yet the Lord rescued me from all of them.
- 12 Indeed, all who want to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted.
- <sup>13</sup> But wicked people and impostors will go from bad to worse, deceiving others and being deceived.
- <sup>14</sup> But as for you, continue in what you have learned and firmly believed, knowing from whom you learned it.
- and how from childhood you have known the sacred writings that are able to instruct you for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.
- <sup>16</sup> All scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness,
- <sup>17</sup> so that everyone who belongs to God may be proficient, equipped for every good work.
- <sup>5</sup> As for you, always be sober, endure suffering, do the work of an evangelist, carry out your ministry fully.
