I want us to focus on these three areas as we begin our new journey. I think Spring City has glorious days ahead, and I pray that we will experience a great awakening to Jesus Christ within the church that will spill out into the streets of Spring City, and will be carried far as we answer the call of Jesus to make disciples in all the world. I look forward to gathering with you, growing with you, and going with you in the coming year.



Angela Jackson sang "It Matters to the Master" with the piano accompaniment of Bryan Massengale for the special music on May 2nd.




Richard Stair sang "The Holy Hills of Heaven Call Me" for the special music on May 16th.


They are registered on Amazon, and there will also be a "money bottle" available to go towards the purchase of a rocking chair for the nursery.
