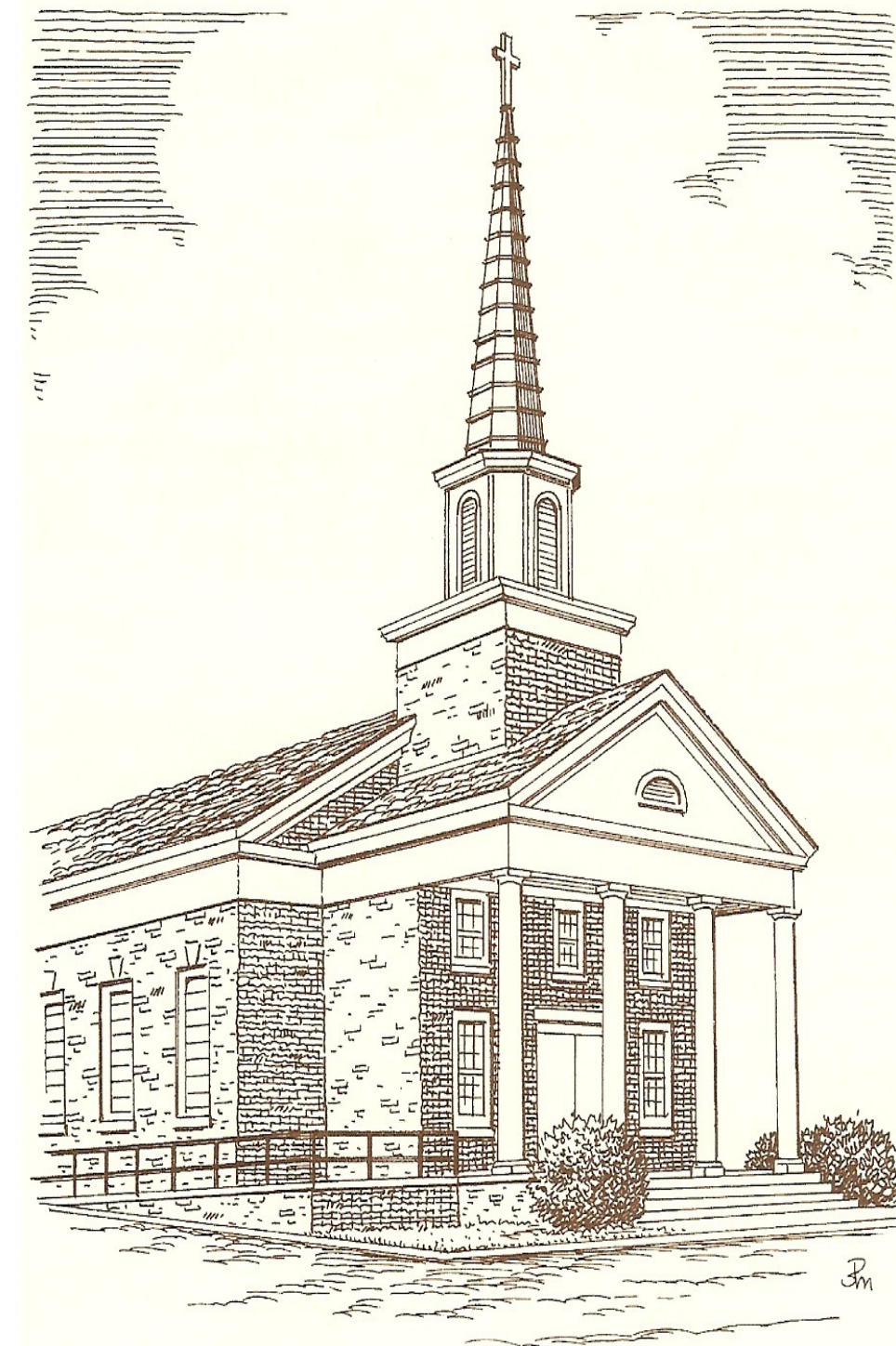
Poinsettias for Christmas

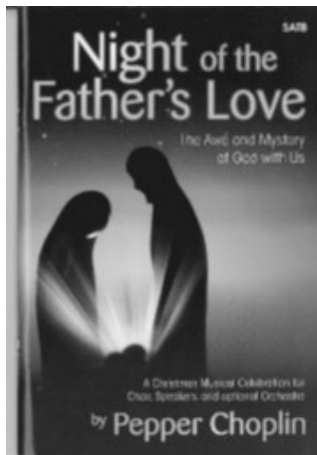
