Luke 19:1-10 (NRSV)**

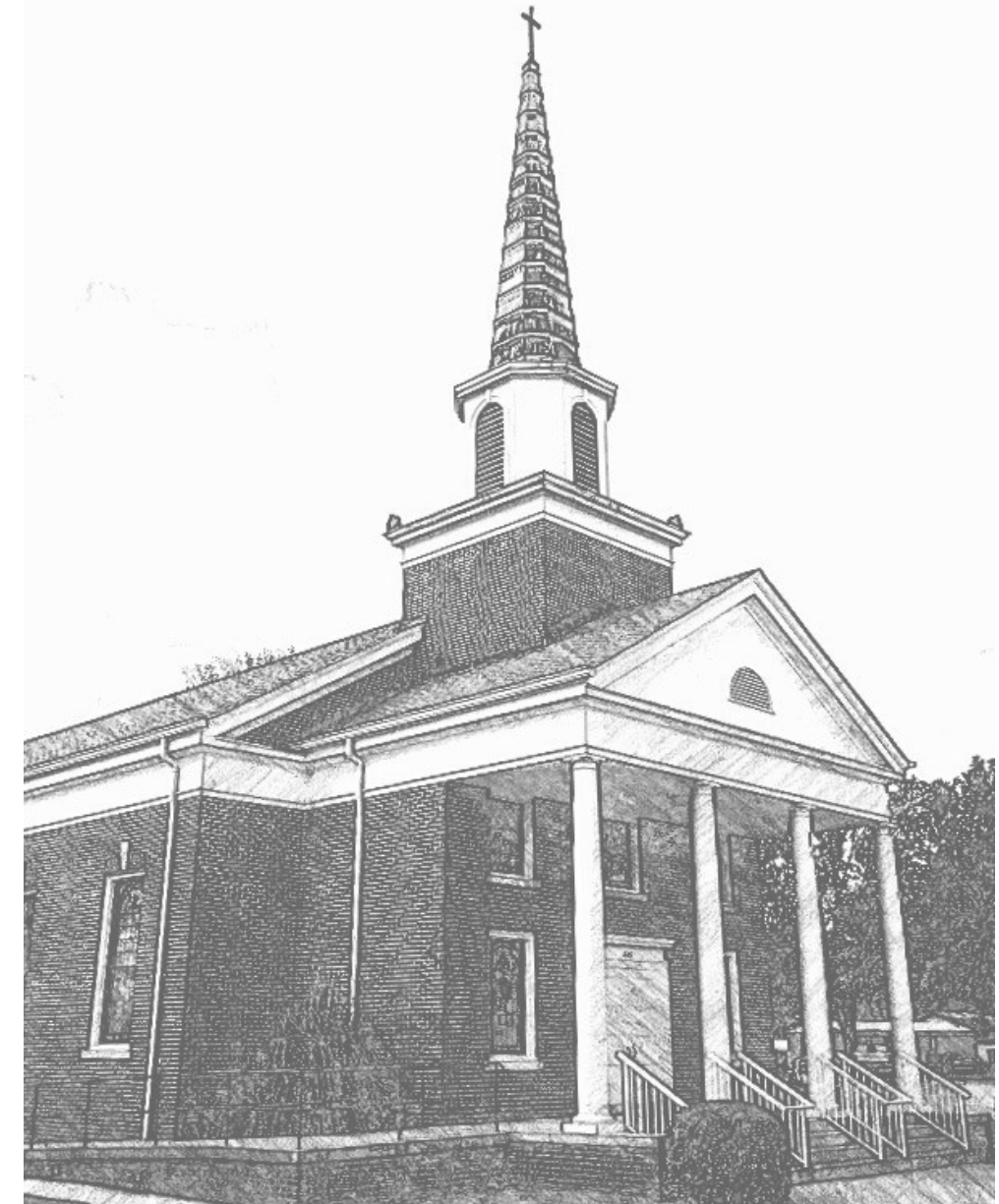
¹ He entered Jericho and was passing through it.
