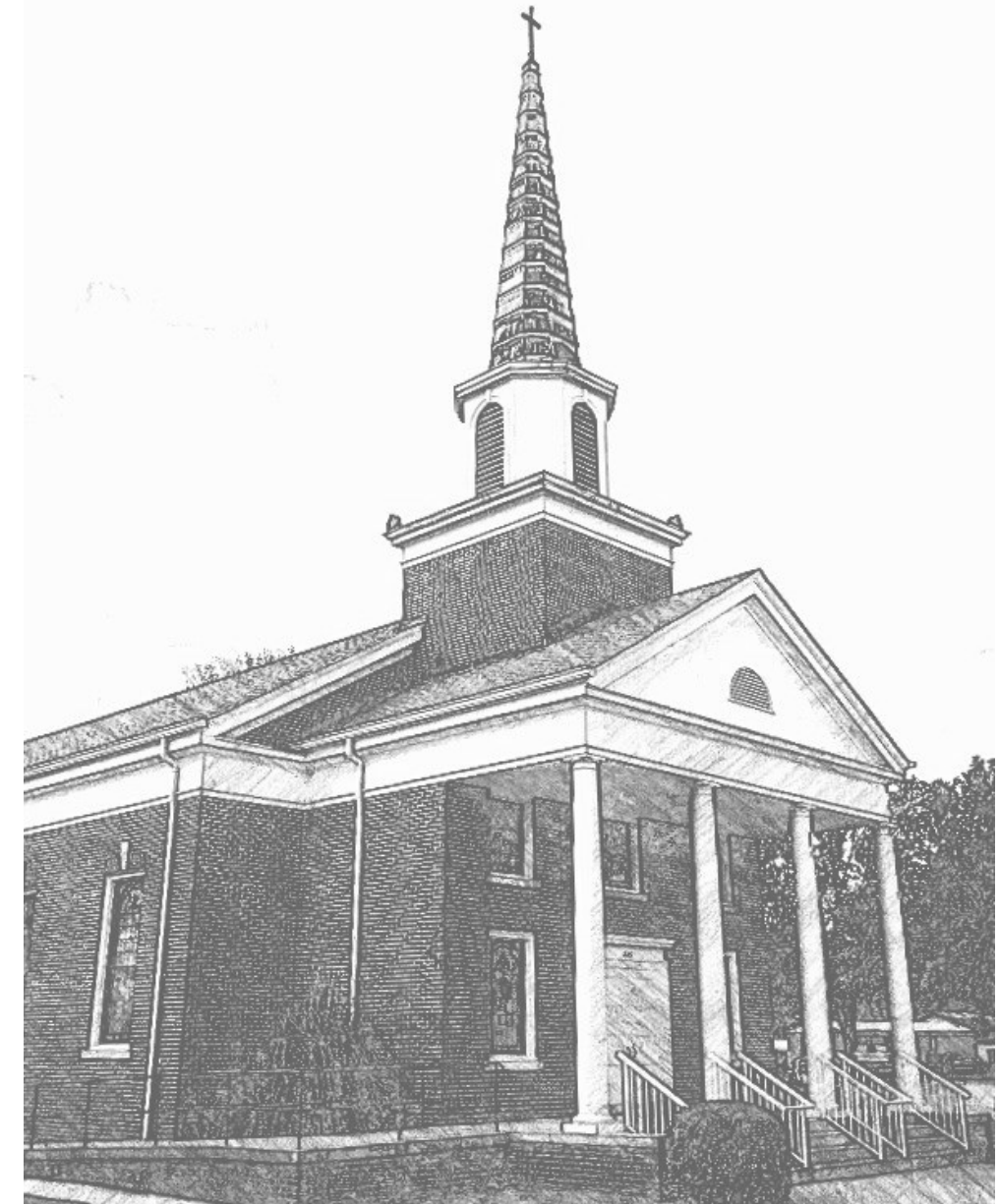
**TODAY'S SCRIPTURE

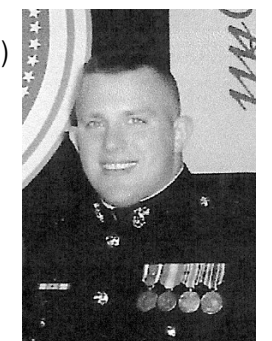
