We are going to do something new! Beginning Wednesday night, November 11th, we will have a Wednesday evening Advent Study. (I know Advent does not start until Nov. 29th, but we are doing the study this way to fit the church's schedule.)

We will study a book entitled, "Not a Silent Night," by Adam Hamilton. The study includes a video component, which we will watch together. Then, we will divide into small groups to discuss what we have seen and read.

There will also be a meal provided by groups connected to the church. We will ask for a donation, which will go toward the work of these various groups.

The schedule is:

6:00 Gather for Supper.

6:20 Video will begin while people are still eating.

6:45 Divide into small groups for discussion.

7:30 Classes and activities for children will be over.

The youth will participate in this same discussion of "Not a Silent Night." The children will partake in another Advent study, which has crafts and activities related to Advent. There will also be a nursery provided for those with small children.

This is a family event, designed for us to think about the significance of Christmas.

- We will do this as families because it helps to redirect our priorities during this time of the year.
- We will do this as a community of faith for it strengthens our witness during this important time of year.
- We will do this for ourselves because it reminds us of the work of Jesus Christ in our lives and focuses us on the most important things in our lives during this time of year.

The dates for this study will be **November 11** and **18**; **December 2, 9,** and **16**. Please make your plans to be here for these 5 sessions.

Another item is that the church office will be closed on Fridays in December.

NOTE: Please bring grocery sacks to the church for the rummage sale.


Donna Vaughn Speaks at LDL
