- 1 bag dried beans (2 lb.)
- 1 box powdered milk (9 oz. or less)
- 1 box oatmeal (18 oz. or less)
- 1 bottle cooking oil (48 oz. or less)
- 2 cans (total) meat: ham, spam or tuna
