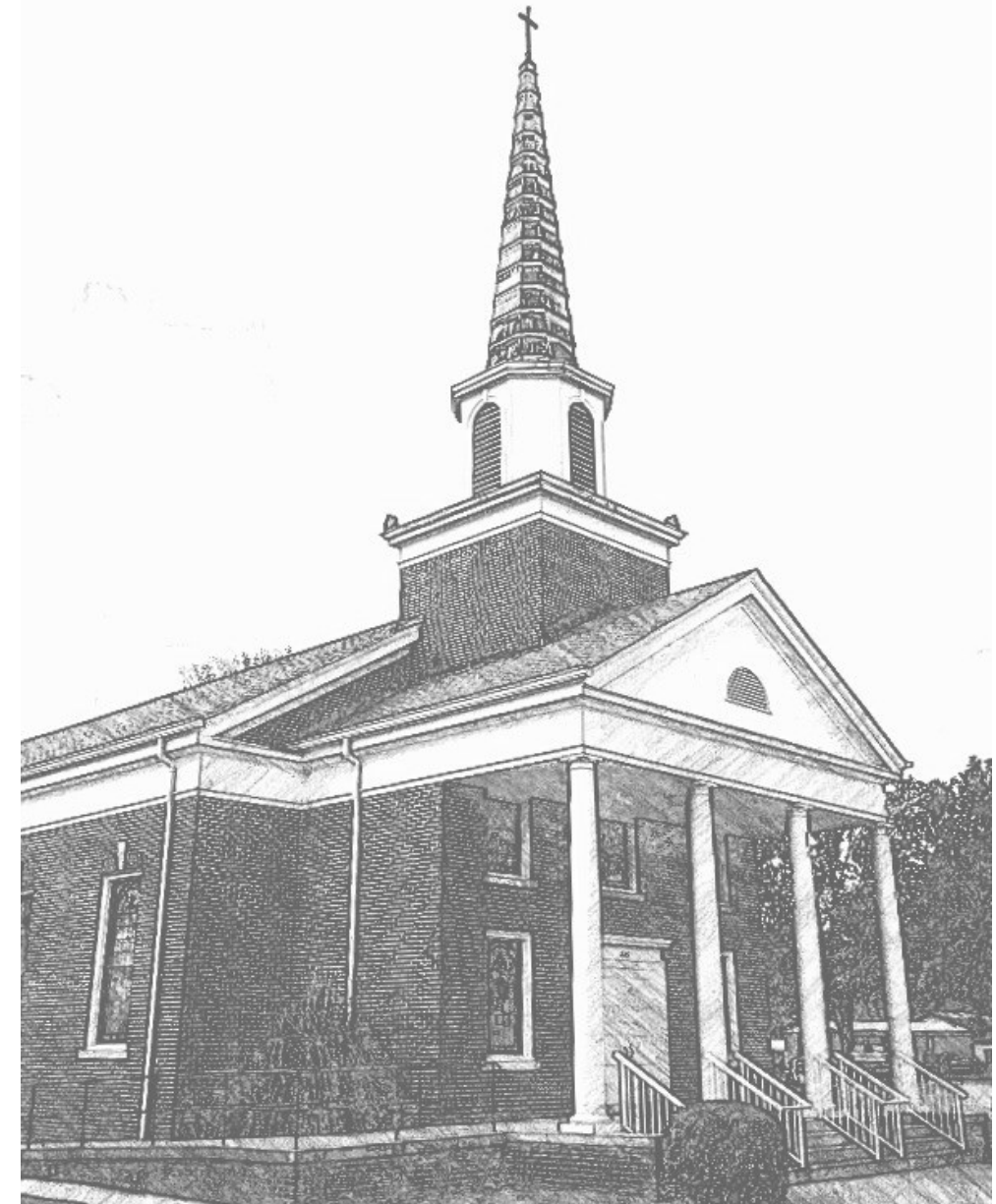
¹ When Jesus saw the crowds, he went up the mountain; and after he sat down, his disciples came to him.
