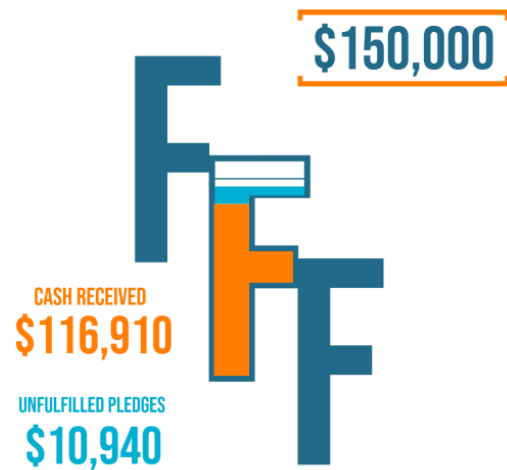

Mexico Medical Mission Update

The Mexico Medical Mission Team is going to Ixtepec, Mexico to provide medical care for indigenous people in a remote area of the Sierra Madre Mountains from April 29-May 7. This population does not have access to medical care locally.

Team members pay their own way but we are asking churches for donations to cover the cost of medications and treatment supplies that we provide free to those we serve.

Please make your check payable to SCUMC and note that it is for the Mexico Medical Mission to support this much needed and important mission.

The health concerns we most often see in the population we serve include high blood pressure, diabetes, parasitic infestation, arthritis, and poor nutrition. We serve those from just a few weeks old to those in their senior years.

Another special need and concern is that so many of our usual health care providers have become unable to go this year due to age or health issues. We desperately need Physicians, Nurse Practitioners and RN's or LPN's to join in serving these people in need.
