Isaiah 43:16-21 (NRSV)**

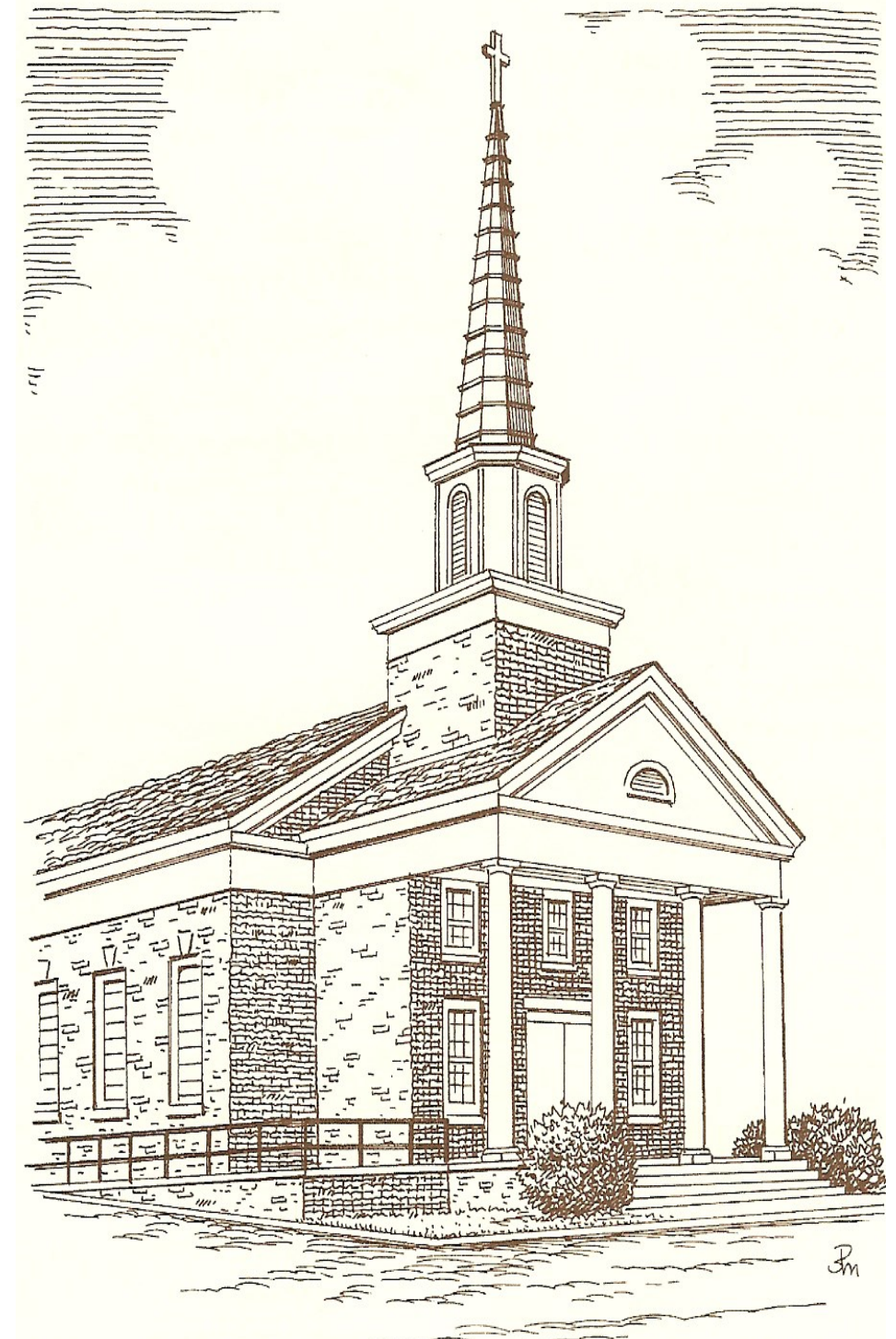
16 Thus says the LORD, who makes a way in the sea, a path in the mighty waters,
