**TODAY'S SCRIPTURE
Exodus 17:1-7 (NRSV)**

¹ From the wilderness of Sin the whole congregation of the Israelites journeyed by stages, as the LORD commanded. They camped at Rephidim, but there was no water for the people to drink.

² The people quarreled with Moses, and said, "Give us water to drink." Moses said to them, "Why do you quarrel with me? Why do you test the LORD?"

³ But the people thirsted there for water; and the people complained against Moses and said, "Why did you bring us out of Egypt, to kill us and our children and livestock with thirst?"

⁴ So Moses cried out to the LORD, "What shall I do with this people? They are almost ready to stone me."

⁵ The LORD said to Moses, "Go on ahead of the people, and take some of the elders of Israel with you; take in your hand the staff with which you struck the Nile, and go.

⁶ I will be standing there in front of you on the rock at Horeb. Strike the rock, and water will come out of it, so that the people may drink." Moses did so, in the sight of the elders of Israel.

⁷ He called the place Massah and Meribah, because the Israelites quarreled and tested the LORD, saying, "Is the LORD among us or not?"

First Presbyterian Church, Spring City, would like to invite you to join us for an evening with International Peacemaker, Rosario Jocabed Gallegos Viesca. This year, we are fortunate to have her come to Spring City and tell us about her ministry at the border of Mexico and the United States.

Jocabed (Joca) is the Mexican Coordinator with Frontera de Cristo, a Presbyterian border ministry located in the sister cities of Douglas, Arizona, and Agua Prieta, Sonora. She is well acquainted with issues of violence, poverty, trade, health care and family life faced by these two cities on the U.S./Mexico border.

Joca graduated from the Presbyterian Seminary in Mexico City and served in the Presbytery of Chihuahua. She worked alongside her father in Hispanic ministry in South Carolina for 3 years, then returned to Mexico to develop her own border ministry. She is a fourth generation Presbyterian, something that is uncommon in northern Mexico.

Following her presentation in the sanctuary, you will have an opportunity to speak with her personally and enjoy apple dumplings and coffee in Hilleary Hall.
